As you know, Governor Wolf and his staff have determined that in order to keep us healthy, school will not reopen this school year. Although this requires us to maintain a physical distance, please know our staff is working hard to keep our students and teachers connected remotely.

Since we won't see our students within our school building for the remainder of the year, we have developed a plan so they can retrieve their personal belongings from their classrooms. Our teachers are working hard this week to collect and coordinate all of their students' personal belongings into individualized bags. We will be distributing these belongings via our drive thru parent pick-up lines, just as we did when distributing packets a few weeks ago.

Please plan on picking up these belongings next week, on Tuesday or Wednesday, April 28 or 29, between the hours of Noon and 3PM. In an effort to keep the line running smoothly, we ask that you clearly display your parent pickup placard on your vehicle's visor. If you don't have your placard, please post your student's last name on a piece of paper and display that instead.

In an effort to maintain the safety of all involved, we ask that this pick-up be contactless. Our helpers will be gloved and masked, and we ask that you please open your trunk or rear passenger window so that we can place the items in your vehicle without contact. Thank you in advance for cooperating with this request.
