2018 Mike Munchak Community Service Scholarship

Dear School District Superintendents/Guidance Departments/Agency Executive Directors:

The United Way of Lackawanna and Wayne Counties has established the aforementioned scholarship program to assist high school students from Lackawanna and Wayne Counties, PA, who plan to pursue a post-secondary education.

To be eligible, candidates must be actively involved in community service activities in programs funded by this United Way, be full-time resident and/or students of school districts within Lackawanna or Wayne Counties and accepted by an accredited university, college or trade school, in a two or four year degree program track, for the 2018/2019 school year.

Following are program eligibility criteria and highlights:

- o The scholarship amount for 2018 is \$6,300.00
- o The scholarship will be awarded for a one (1) year period only
- Only open to graduating seniors within our school districts
- o Demonstrate commitment through community service activities
- Demonstrate academic achievement
- Applicants must be graduating seniors from a public, private, parochial or charter school within either of the two counties

Scholarship packets including applications have been enclosed with this announcement to each school district in the Lackawanna and Wayne County area in December 2017. Please note that one component of the application is a Letter of Recommendation for the student from either you or your designee.

All completed application packets must be returned no later than March 31, 2018. Any incomplete packets will not be considered. Send to:
